According to the World Health Organization, **35** of every **100** of women **WORLD WIDE** have experienced either physical and/or sexual intimate partner violence or non-partner sexual violence.<sup>2</sup>

Some national violence studies show that up to **70%** of women have experienced physical and/or sexual violence in their lifetime from an intimate partner.<sup>2</sup>
